Calgary Minor Soccer Association (CMSA)

- Team Schedules are available from the CMSA site (please ensure you to go CMSA to get your schedule) – [click here](#).
- PDP Schedules are available from the Rangers site – [click here](#).
- Team Officials reminder of the following:
 - o Team Officials should have received their CMSA Log in information. If you have not received the information please contact Sheila at registration@calgaryrangers.com. Once you log in, from your Team Roster you will see Proof of Age and Player Waiver information for your team. All Rangers players Proof of Age documents have been completed. If you have players that have a "NO" in the Player Waiver column they must complete the waiver or contact Sheila at registration@calgaryrangers.com to get the waiver resent to the parents.
 - o From your Team Roster you will see Team Officials that do not have a current CPIC (police clearance). For instruction on how to complete your CPIC [click here](#). Note that you can get your CPIC completed at the same time as your CMSA picture ID. Team officials must have completed their CPIC to be eligible to be on the bench for games.
 - o Please ensure that all your players (U12 to U18) and Team Officials (for U10 to U18) have their CMSA picture ID – [click here](#) for instructions on how to get your card.
 - o Goalie PDP is free for those players that have signed up for regular PDP. Goalie PDP starts on Oct 22nd at Olympic Heights from 10:00 to 11:00 a.m. for U8 to U12 and 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for U14 to U18.
 - o NCCP coaching courses - October 22 (Child Course); October

22 & 23 (Youth Course). If you have not signed up, you need to sign up right away. Please contact Sheila at registration@calgaryrangers.com to sign up.

- Rangers coaches are invited to attend our first coaches clinic to be held on Friday, October 28th from 7:30 to 9:00 at the Edge.
