



# **Standard: Volunteer Screening**

## **Purpose**

The Calgary Rangers Soccer Club (CRSC) requires a volunteer screening process to help safeguard young and vulnerable members of the club.

### **Application**

This Standard applies to volunteers in a position of trust and persons who have access to vulnerable people.

#### **Roles & Accountabilities**

#### **Board & Club Administrator:**

• Oversee the process to ensure volunteer screening is being carried out according to this Standard.

#### Volunteers:

- Coaches and officials require completion of the Calgary Police electronic Police Information Check (ePIC)
- Coaches and officials require completion of the "Respect in Soccer" course for the Calgary Minor Soccer Association (CMSA).

#### **Definitions:**

**Volunteer** – includes Club executive, coaches, assistant coaches, managers, and trainers.

Determine Acceptability – Screening Officer	<ul> <li>Review for any of the following:</li> <li>Sexual offences</li> <li>Violent or threatening behaviour against children or adults</li> <li>Conduct against public morals, including disorderly conduct, rioting, public indecency, vagrancy, loitering, gang activity, prostitution and solicitation, obscenity, and cruelty to animals</li> <li>Substance or chemical abuse occurring in the preceding five (5) years</li> <li>Violation of a position of trust, including theft or fraud occurring in the preceding five (5) years</li> <li>Criminal driving offences, including but not limited to impaired driving</li> <li>Violation of any government regulations or licensing privileges</li> <li>Determine the acceptability of an applicant, either:</li> <li>a. Accepted</li> <li>b. Accepted with conditions</li> </ul>
